

MATERIAL REVIEW

[Project Roadmap](#) is a TTA (Training and Technical Assistance) Provider funded by OVC to support ECM Task Forces. One way we support task forces is by reviewing materials at the request of OVC and/or the task forces. Our expert review supports task forces deliver high quality, impactful trainings and materials that reflect up-to-date content and best practices.



NOTE: This document explains the review process and includes a helpful list with tips for creating materials.

AWARD CONDITION LANGUAGE

(see award package documentation for full text)

“The recipient agrees to submit to OJP for review and approval any product...that will be developed and published under this award, 60 days before its intended publication. The recipient agrees to correct a product in response to comments generated through the OJP peer review process, the internal Department of Justice review process, or as otherwise requested by OJP.” (e.g., curricula, training materials, publications, reports, videos, or any other written, web-based, or audio-visual, or other materials)



NOTE: Many ECMs choose to receive TTA Feedback before submitting materials to OVC for approval. OVC provides final approval of any materials or deliverables.

WHAT IS THE MATERIAL REVIEW PROCESS?



STEP 1: Create the material.

Remember to:*

- include the OVC disclaimer
- cite your sources
- double check the definition of trafficking is correct
- include both sex and labor
- include all victims – adults, minors, male, female

*This list applies to most materials. Grant Manager has final discretion.



STEP 2: Send the draft material to Project Roadmap for review.

STEP 3: Project Roadmap will review the material and provide feedback within 2 weeks.

Be on the lookout for:

- an email with suggested changes; and/or
- a request for a virtual meeting to discuss suggested changes



STEP 4: Meet with Project Roadmap to discuss suggested edits.

Virtual connections provide an opportunity to ensure clear understanding of suggestions and the ability to answer questions, soundboard; etc.
